## a new solution

Strive for College is a new approach to college access: it recruits undergraduate student mentors from local universities to guide low-income high school students through the process of applying to, enrolling in and paying for four-year colleges institutions. The Strive approach focuses on building communities; chapters use a flexible curriculum and online mentoring platform, Strive Online, to connect students with opportunities and maintain accountability.

## proven results

In 2006, just 1 of the 30 graduating seniors at Eskridge High School in Wellston, Missouri went to college. Two years later, Strive for College's pilot model helped 24 of the 27 graduating seniors enroll in four-year colleges and universities.

## transformative potential

Strive aims to replicate the success of its pilot model at schools across America. Thanks to its chapter- and Web-based approach, Strive has the potential to scale nationally and help thousands of students while remaining cost effective and efficient.
